

Introduction: Systematic testing for Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome CoronaVirus-2 (SARS-CoV-2) using molecular diagnostic tools to identify individuals with coronavirus disease 2019 (CDVID-19) infection, and tracing their primary and secondary contacts is important to curb its spread. With resource limitations on testing individual samples, testing of pooled samples provides alternative approach to increase testing capacity. Present aimed at assessing the detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA in pooled samples using chip-based real-time polymerase chain reaction Test (Truenat'* Beta CoV).

Materials and Methods: Pooled sample size of five was used from laboratory confirmed COVID-19 positive and negative samples. SARS-CoV-2 positive nasopharyngeol specimens of known samples from high, medium, low, and very low viral load were mixed with SARS-CoV-2 negative nasopharyngeal specimens of known samples in 1:4 ratio, followed by analysis using Truenas. Furthermore, each sample in that pool was tested individually. Pooled sample testing was also done on the samples of unknown status.

Results: The results of the present study showed cycle threshold (Ct) values of pooled sample with SARS-CoV-2 positive RNA of high, medium, low, and very low viral load were 16.8, 24.22, 28.2, and 33.43, compared to Ct values of individual samples of 16.43, 22.0, 28.00, and 33.00, respectively.

Conclusion: These results suggest that the Ct values of pooled samples were in agreement with Ct values of individual samples indicating the validity of pooled sample testing for screening SARS-CoV-2 using Toward.

Then the fermented culture was transferred to the photosynthetic unit where the fermented culture was incubated till a change in its colour (transfer of energy). Then the liquid obtained is dried and powdered. The feed which is in the form of powder (solid) was packed accordingly to the market need. Other equipments used in

the industry were: fermenter, electric spray drier, autoclave, shaking incubator, rotatory shaker, hot air oven, weighing balance, calorimeter, U.V light filter, pH meter, Hot plate, heating mantle. The end products produced by the company are Natural Aqua Feed Supplement and Natural Animal Feed Supplement.

OUTCOME:

The educational tour of the Hi-tech pharma industry in Nellore is an excellent opportunity for students to get an insight into the working of the industry.

The tour covers all the significant aspects of the industry, from the manufacturing process to product development.

Students acquired knowledge regarding the instrumentation involved in the R&D conditions in the industry, the actual production process, downstream processing and packing.

Students and faculty members also got a chance to interact with industry experts and get their valuable feedback.






