Oceans, seas and coastal areas form an integrated and essential component of the Earth's ecosystem and are critical to sustainable development. They cover more than two-thirds of the earth's surface and contain 97% of the planet's water. Over three billion people depend on marine and coastal resources for their livelihoods. In addition, oceans are crucial for global food security and human health. They are also the primary regulator of the global climate, an important sink for greenhouse gases and they provide us with water and the oxygen we breathe. Finally, oceans host huge reservoirs of biodiversity. The link between oceans, seas and marine resources and human well-being is not one-sided. While an increase in human well-being is frequently generated at the cost of ecosystem integrity, it can also potentially reduce the negative anthropogenic impacts on the marine environment.

Oceans, seas and marine resources are increasingly threatened, degraded or destroyed by human activities, reducing their ability to provide crucial ecosystem services. Important classes of threats are, among others, climate change, marine pollution, unsustainable extraction of marine resources and physical alterations and destruction of marine and coastal habitats and landscapes. The deterioration of coastal and marine ecosystems and habitats is negatively affecting human well-being worldwide.

In view of this, it is essential to bring awareness among students, researchers, academics, users and regulators through a common forum like MPESSE-2019. The Conference will provide a forum for experts from all over the country to meet and discuss their frontier research, and the latest scientific and technological advancements in this important field. It also helps the participants understanding local, regional and global marine

pollution problems and their solutions, issues of ecotoxicology hoping that such problems will be more easily resolved in the future for the build-up of sustainable ecosystem.

River and river pollution and industrial effluents were the major culprits in marine life being adversely affected, said vice-chancellor of Vikrama Simhapuri University Prof. Sudharshan Rao.

He was addressing a national conference on marine pollution and ecotoxicology—strategies for sustainable ecosystems after inauguration at the University on Wednesday.

He observed that pollution is accumulating in rivers and seas could affect the livelihood of fisherman living along the coastline due to low production of fish.

The vice-chancellor urged the participating scientists to develop a mechanism to curtail marine pollution and suggest policy decisions to be taken up by the Government for implementation.

He elaborated on his

extensive research activities and the neurotoxic effect on children and pregnant women by metals like lead and arsenic. These metals were major pollutants observed in the geographical locations of Bangladesh and Uttar Pradesh of our country, he said. Based on his 20 years of research work, he suggested that nutrient supplements and MADMISA (Monoisocyanyl meso 2,3-dimercaptosuccinic acid) could be some remedial measures to combat metal toxicity.

Prof. M. Srinivasulu Reddy, S.V. University, Tirupathi and Prof. B. Babu, Andhra Univers-

ity, Vishakhapatnam also took part in the seminar.

The organising secretary of the conference said that the conference had received abstracts from 70 participants from different parts of the country including Presidency University, Kolkata, National Institute of Oceanography, Goa, Osmania University, Hyderabad and other reputed state and Central Universities.

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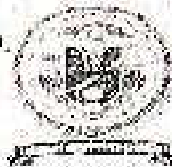

Summary Report on the Objective, Recommendations and Important Personnel of UGC National Seminar on "Performance Evaluation of Employment Generation and Poverty Alleviation Schemes in India" held on 13-14th February 2019

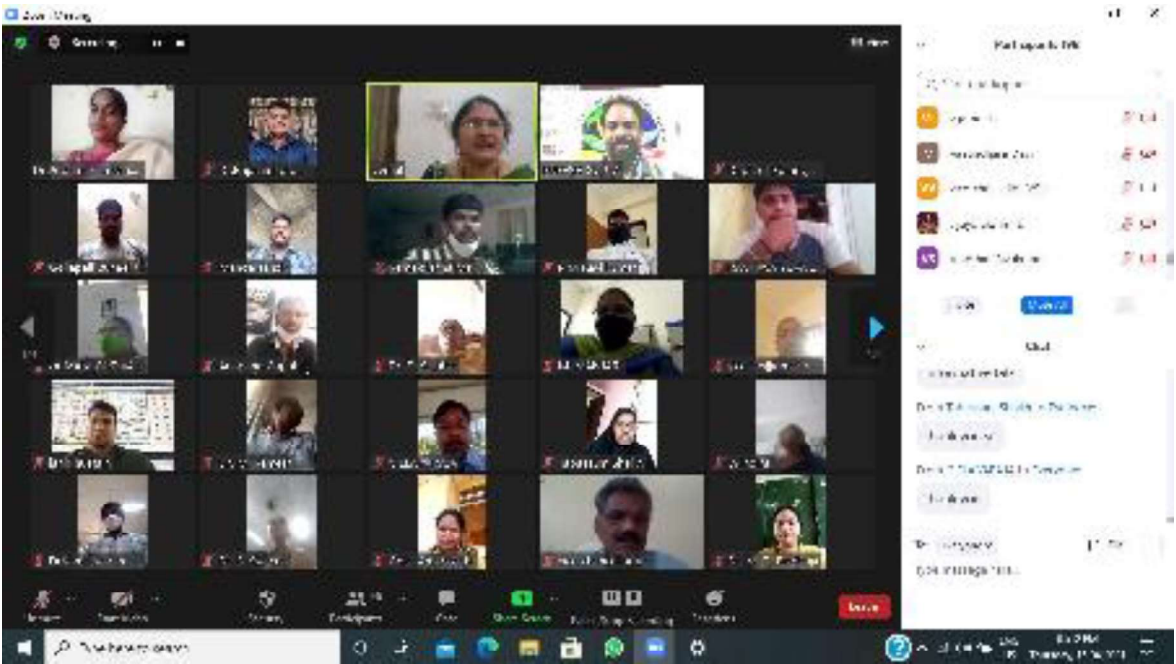

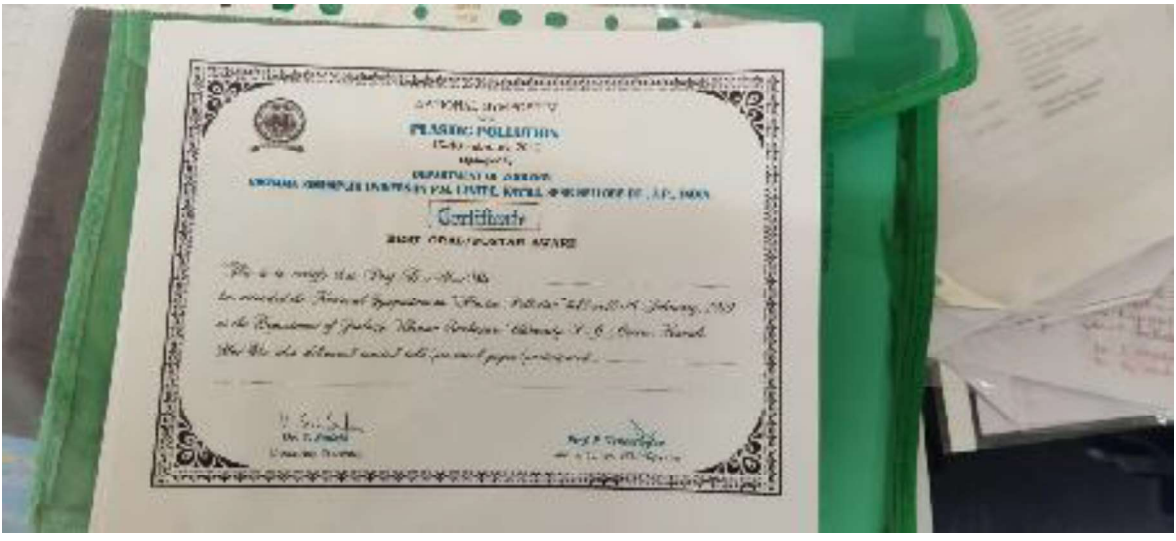

Workshop Implementation:

The workshop started at 10 am with highly enthusiastic faculty of University Departments and NSS Program Officers.

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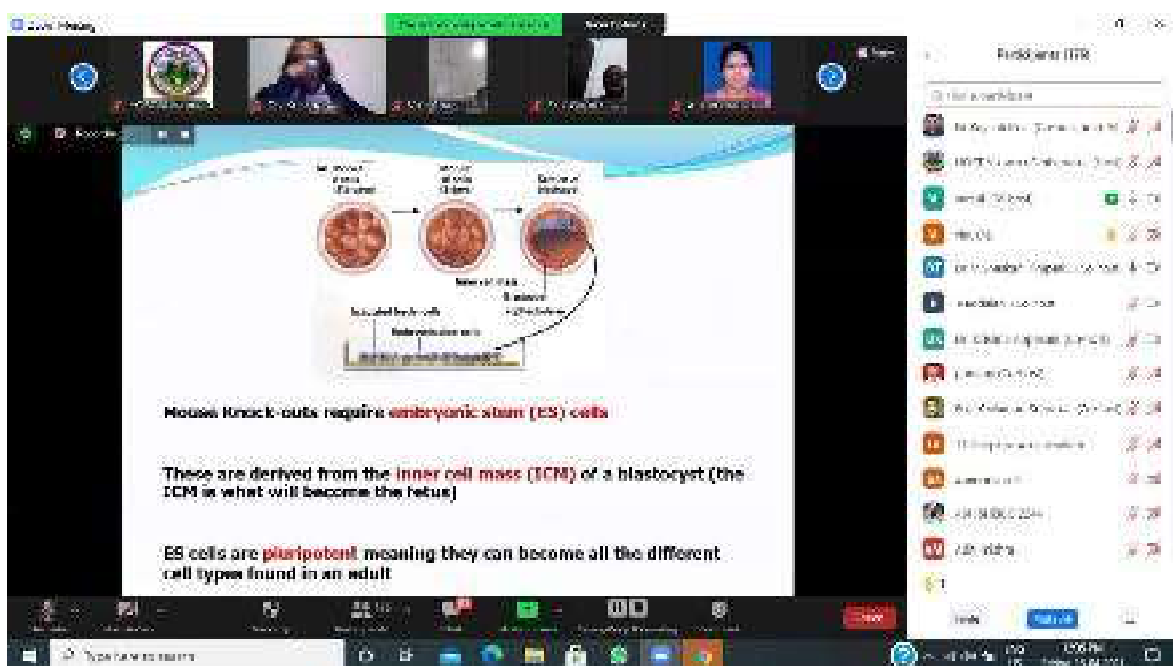
International webinar on Recent advances in Genetic Engineering

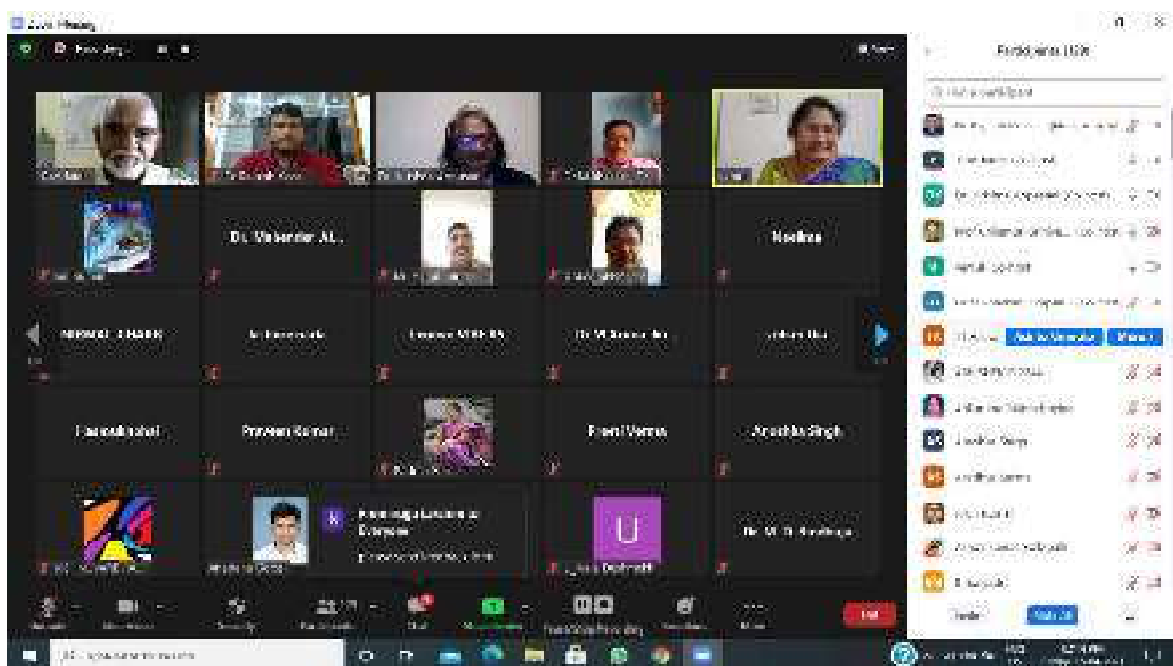

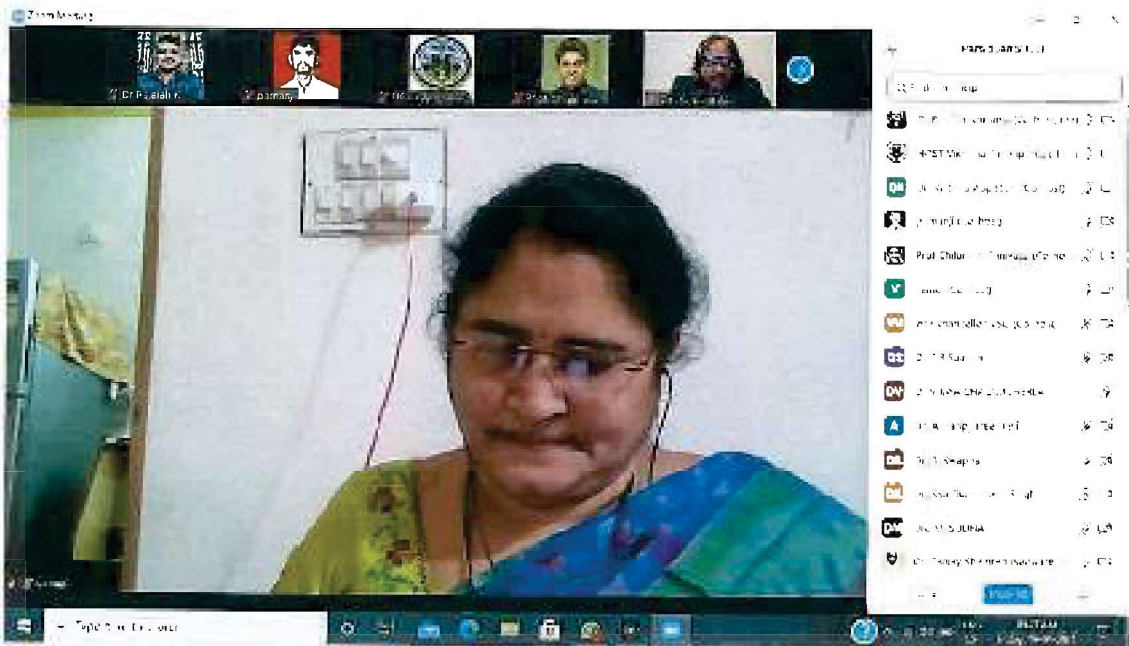

Workshop Implementation:

The workshop started at 10 am with highly enthusiastic faculty of University Departments.
