

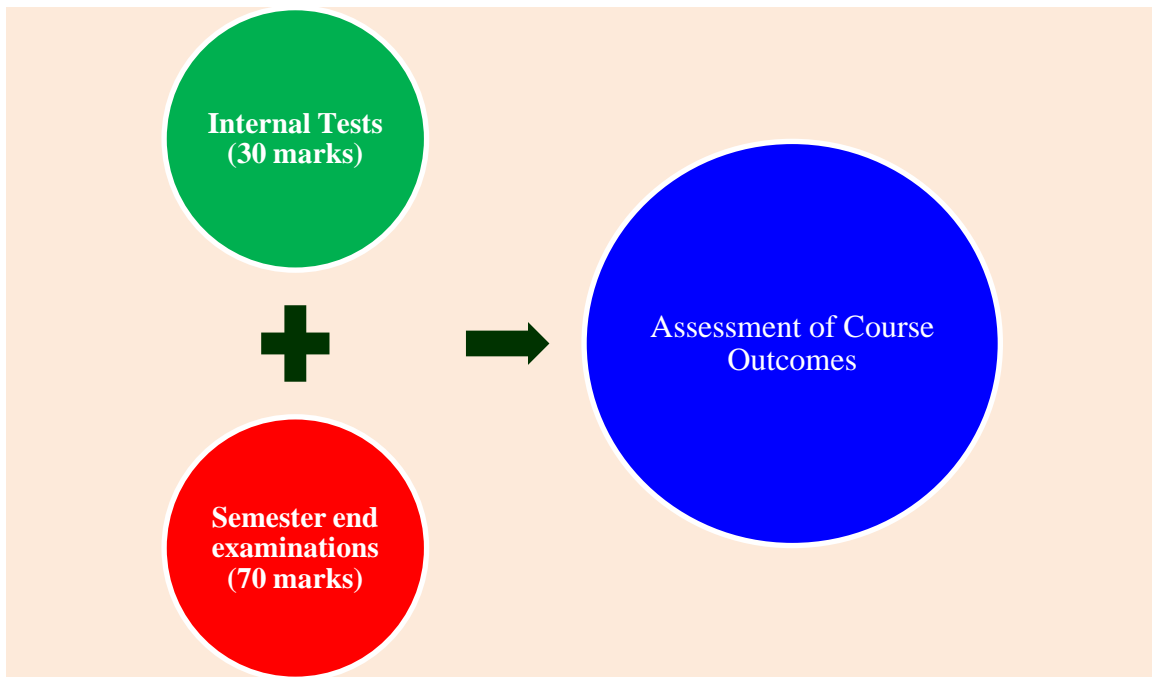

Assessment Tools	Process
<b>Internal Tests</b>	
Mid examinations	Internal marks are based on two mid examinations conducted in a semester. After the each mid examination the question are discussed in the class room by the concern teacher to enable the students to improve in the subject and also for the final semester end examination.
<b>Semester end examinations</b>	
Semester end theory examination	The semester end examinations are conducted in descriptive manner for each course.
Semester end practical examinations	The semester end practical examinations are conducted for practical observations for laboratory courses.
Dissertations/Seminars/Projects/ Internship /Field Work/ Community Engagement Report (Viva-voce)	Viva-voce examination of dissertation/ project work is conducted at the end of semester theory examination. Viva-voce is conducted by the internal as well as the external examiners who are nominated by the Vice-chancellor

Attainment of Course Outcomes in a course is set as 30% from internal tests and 70% from semester end examinations.
