There will be no extension of time beyond 3 years. The Registration shall get cancelled automatically if the candidate fails to submit before 3 years. However the scholar may request for re-registration and extension for submission of thesis. The candidate should submit the joining report along with a copy of the fee receipt to the Principal, DCAC.

In case the guide is from a department other than the department where the candidate is registered, the joining report and all the future correspondence should be forwarded by the Head of the Department where the candidate is registered through University College concerned department and Principal.

In case of interdisciplinary research the candidate shall be awarded the degree in the subject in which he/she registered, mentioning the title of the Thesis. In case of interdisciplinary themes involving two or more disciplines, the Chairpersons Board of Studies (PG-Combined) of the subject in which the candidate has registered for Ph.D shall provide the panel of examiners in addition to the panel given by the Supervisors.

The candidates shall present seminar within six months to finalize the Ph.D title and shall complete 14 credits before submission of synopsis.

All the Research Scholars have to be physically present for the teaching classes throughout this semester and shall have to maintain the required 75% of attendance based on which the candidate will be permitted to attend Ph.D examination. However, if the candidate do not have the required minimum 75% of attendance in the subject, he/she will be detained in those subjects, and shall have to reappear for class work in those subjects again and then appear for the pre-Ph.D examination as and when it is conducted. There is no revaluation for Pre-Ph.D examination.

The exact title of research programme is to be approved by the DRC committee before the submission of the thesis. This should be exactly the same as the thesis copy being submitted, as approved and finalized by the DRC committee. There should not be any change in the title once it is approved by the colloquium committee.

The registration of a Ph.D scholar may be cancelled by the BRS within the stipulated period if the candidate fails to satisfy the conditions stipulated in the admission order or violated the rules and regulations of Ph.D after giving notice to the concerned candidate. 
